Cruising between four islands - Molokai, Lanai, Maui, and Hawaii the Big Island - experience a new Aloha aboard a 36-guest boutique yacht. Culture, volcano hikes, and wildlife searches await.



ITINERARY

DAY 1 Molokai – Embarkation

Welcome to Hawaii! You'll be transferred to our hospitality area on Molokai. Later, the captain and crew greet you with smiles and champagne as you board the awaiting Safari Explorer. This evening, settle in and enjoy dinner aboard the yacht, before a presentation about your week ahead. (D)

DAY 2 Molokai

A warm aloha spirit gives you a sense of Hawaii long ago. No stop lights, no high-rises, just a welcome slower pace. "Talk story" with locals and experience their land and traditions as few visitors do. You'll hear legends and lore, then take in a cultural lesson in taro patches and poi making, or hike to a towering waterfall in Halawa's cathedral valley--one of the island's most historic places. At the Molokai Museum, discover the history of this ancient homeland as you enjoy an evening pa'ina (feast), complete with a home-style Hawaiian jam session. (BLD)



DAY 3 Lana'i

Gear up for a day of play on the "Private Island." Thousand-foot sea cliffs line the shore and ancient volcanic plugs sit both above and below the water's surface as host to a wide diversity of marine life. Suit your fancy and the weather - explore Lanai village, snorkel, or take a bike excursion. (BLD)

DAY 4 Off Coast Maui

Today we may snorkel among coral gardens teeming with underwater life and a known sea turtle habitat. The Humpback National Marine Sanctuary located between Lana'i, Molokai, and Maui provides front-row seats as you cruise through these productive breeding grounds searching for dolphins, whales, and other marine life. Look above and below the surface. (BLD)

DAY 5 Captain's Choice

Embark on an unforgettable trip to the captivating seascapes of Hawaii. Your day may include a kayaking adventure along Maui's hidden coves, paddling through turquoise waters, and discovering the untouched beauty of its coastline. Transition to Lana'i, where kayaking takes you to remote areas between the cerulean ocean and lush greenery. You may cruise along Moloka'i's dramatic northern cliffs, experiencing the awe-inspiring vista of soaring precipices and an occasional frolicking dolphin. As the day unfolds, enjoy cruising for critters and charismatic sea life from the top deck, savoring some of our signature drinks while expert naturalist guides introduce you to the rich marine life and bird species that call these waters home. (BLD)

DAY 6 Kona Coast & Manta Ray Snorkel

Snorkel, kayak, or swim - From the tiniest fish to the widest stretch of coral, it's all spectacular. Depending on weather and your mood, spend the day in the

water or let us do the work, and explore the rugged coastline on a skiff ride. This evening you'll anchor at an offshore location to search for and night snorkel with Giant Pacific Manta rays. This award-winning excursion offers snorkelers the opportunity to observe these majestic animals up close and personal. Marine life is often within inches, offering a unique experience with wild animals in their environment. Strict guidelines are followed to lessen any disturbance of these beautiful creatures. (BLD)

DAY 7 Big Island

This morning, Join us on a rocky hike up the cool and misty slopes of Hualalai Volcano. Explore our private trail at 6,500ft above the Kona coast with your own naturalist guide. Cross surreal scenes of black lava flows, pass pit craters, and stroll through native dryland forest. You'll discover a lava tube and learn how lava flows from the early 19th century re-shaped the coastline below you. Enjoy magnificent vistas and walk amidst stunning lava formations in a forest of native birdsong. For your final afternoon, relax onboard or go for one last dip. This evening celebrate with the Captain's Dinner and photographic recap of your adventure. (BLD)

DAY 8 Kona Disembarkation

As the Safari Explorer docks at the Kailua - Kona Pier, you'll be transferred to the Kona Airport or to your extended UnCruise hotel stay. (B)

Safari Explorer is designed for upscale comfort in the pursuit of adventure.

This high-end SUV of a yacht is nimble, strong, and loving. The Safari Explorer has what mariners call "feet" that take her into wild areas big ships can't visit. Her performance-built rugged construction means access to faraway regions. But it's what's on the inside that makes this vessel the prize of the fleet. And with only 36 guests on board, the feel is decidedly exclusive. Lovingly called "the Bulldog," she's poised, her interior is a pearl, and the general mood is down-to-earth. In the winter, she bops around the islands of Hawaii soaking up the laid-back aloha spirit—weaving through the islands, ready for bow-riding dolphins. In the summer, she follows the Humpbacks north to Alaska, navigating the inside passage and taking in The Great Land. A protective spirit is infused in every part of the ship, and within the crew. She's made for adventures after all and with them comes inevitable fun and folly.

Three decks accessible to guests are designed for your comfort and sense of adventure. The bridge deck offers the rooftop sun lounge, exercise equipment, hot tub (open during Alaska cruises only), open bridge, and the Commodore Suites. The cabin deck

houses guests in the Navigator and Trailblazer categories, as well as the Jr Commodore and one Admiral cabin. The main deck holds the larger Admiral suites as well as the luxurious common areas.

The dining room features open-seating meals served at table at set times. Unlimited beverages including wines and spirits are included in the price of the cruise. Vegetarian, gluten-free, and dairy-free options are always available, and dietary restrictions are happily accommodated if noted in advance. The main deck also houses the salon and bar area.

Onboard Amenities

Kayaks, paddle boards, inflatable skiffs, hiking poles, snorkel gear. One on-deck hot tub (open during Alaska cruises only), fitness equipment and yoga mats, rubber boots (from women's size five to men's size 12), reusable water bottles, movie and book library, and a full-beam swim step for loading and offloading.

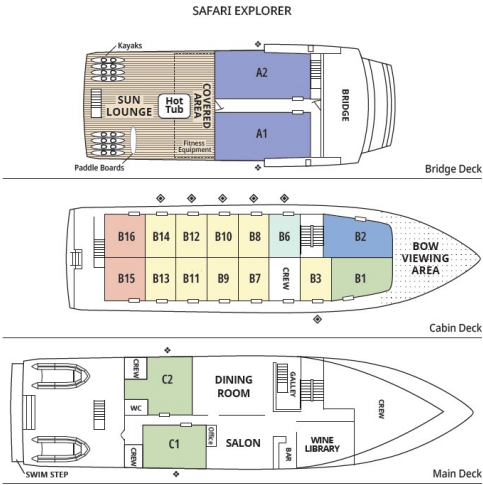
