ITINERARY

Day 1 - SPLIT - SUPETAR (L)

Check-in begins at 13:00. Set sail from Split to the island of Bra while enjoying lunchand meeting your fellow passengers and crew. Upon arrival in Supetar, the island'scapital, enjoy a warm-up hiking tour through the town's charming streets and scenicsurroundings. Overnight in Supetar.

Walking time:approx 1,5h

Day 2 - SUPETAR - MAKARSKA (B, L)





After breakfast onboard, sail towards Makarska, nestled beneath the majestic BiokovoMountain, Croatia's second-highest range. Upon arrival, transfer to the mountain hut'Pod Vošcem' and embark on a guided hike through this breathtaking landscape. Afterwards, return to Makarska for the evening. Overnight in Makarska.

Walking time:approx2h

Day 3 - MAKARSKA - MLJET (B, L, CD)

Enjoy breakfast as you sail towards the lush island of Mljet. Arrive in Pomena andsavourlunch onboard before exploring Mljet National Park on a guided hike(entrancefee to be paid on the spot). Highlights include the saltwater lakes and the climb toMontokuc Peak (235m) for spectacular views. Refresh with a swim in the lakes uponreturn. Captain's Dinner onboard. Overnight in Pomena.

Walking time:approx 3,5h

Day 4- MLJET - VELA LUKA (B, L)

Cruise to Vela Luka on the island of Kor ula, then embark on a hiking tour toHum Hill (376m). As you ascend, enjoy panoramic views of Vela Luka Bay, theopen sea, and nearby islands. Descend to visit Vela Špilja, an importantarchaeological site(Entrancefee). Return to the port for the night. Overnight inVela Luka.

Walking time:approx 3,5h

Day 5 - VELA LUKA - HVAR - STARI GRAD (B, L)

Sail to Hvar Town and visit the iconic ŠpanjolaFortress, offering breathtakingviews of the town and surrounding archipelago (entrance fee). After lunchonboard, continue to Stari Grad with a swim stop en route. Enjoytheafternoonat leisure in Stari Grad.

Walking time:40 min

Day 6 - STARI GRAD - BOL (B, L)

Begin your day with a morning hiking tourfromStari Gradto Purkin Kuk, an ancientfortified settlement featuring megalithic walls. Upon return and after lunch onboard, sail to Bol on the island of Bra. Explore the town and enjoy a scenic walk to the world-famous ZlatniRat (Golden Horn) beach. The evening isfree for leisure. Overnight inBol.

Walking time: 2.5 hours

Day 7 - BOL - ŠOLTA - SPLIT (B, L)

Depart Bol and cruise to Šolta, stopping at Stomorska for a hike up to Gornje Selo,where vistas of the Adriatic await. Upon return, lunch onboard, followed by thesailback to Split. Spend your final afternoon exploring Diocletian's Palace and the vibrantOld Town. Overnight in Split.

Walking time: 2.5 hours

Day 8 - SPLIT (B)

Enjoy breakfast onboard before disembarking by 09:00. Bid farewell to your fellowadventurers and crew, concluding your Walk & HikeDalmatia Cruise

These 'comfort' cruises are run on a small variety of vessels, all of very similar standard, but the actual vessel isn't usually confirmed until 2 weeks before the cruise.

All of the vessels are very comfortable, and the cabins have airconditioning and en-suite bathrooms. All the vessels carry around 38 passengers (maximum).

Steel hulled vessels with modern traditional look offer accommodation in air-conditioned, spacious en-suite cabins with double or twin beds, hair dryer and safety deposit box. Ships are from 29to 35m in length with cabins 8 to 14m2 in size.

Included services: buffet breakfasts, three course lunches, Captain's dinner, English speaking tour manager on board, one guided tour, daily cabin service, mid-week fresh set of towels and bed linen, luggage handling.

The images here are examples of these vessels, and their cabins and decks.

Most vessels have a few triple cabins. These either have a double bed and a single bed, or sometimes a double and a single bunk.

The vessels are all family run and provide plenty of space.
