SATURDAY: TROGIR - PRIMOSTEN (D)

Check-in from 13:00h at Marina Baoti , followed by departure at 14:00h. As you step aboard, enjoy a refreshing welcome cocktail while the cruise sets off through the glistening Adriatic. En route to Trogir, take in the stunning coastal scenery and stop for a relaxing swim in one of the secluded bays. Afternoon arrival in Trogir, a UNESCO-protected gem often called a "miniature Venice." With its 3,000-year-old heritage, charming alleyways, and Romanesque Gothic architecture, this town invites you to explore at your own pace. Docked overnight in Trogir port, enjoy dinner on board, soak in the ambience and discover the magic of this historic town under the stars.

SUNDAY: TROGIR – SKRADIN / KRKA WATERFALLS - ŠIBENIK (B, T)

Awaken to the start of your northern journey and enjoy a sumptuous breakfast as the cruise sets course for Skradin. Take in the ever-changing coastal scenery and pause for a refreshing morning swim in the crystal-clear Adriatic. Upon arrival in Skradin, set off for a memorable visit to a local winery, where a guided tasting of fine regional wines is paired with a light tapas lunch -- a perfect indulgence. Next, discover the natural wonders of Krka National Park, where cascading waterfalls and lush landscapes create a serene escape. In the late afternoon, the journey continues to Šibenik. Upon docking, join a guided tour through the city's historic old town, home to significant landmarks including the magnificent UNESCO-listed Cathedral of St. James. Spend the evening at your leisure wandering the old streets or dining in one of Šibenik's inviting local restaurants, where regional flavours come to life. Overnight in Šibenik.

MONDAY: ŠIBENIK – NP KORNATI – TELAŠ ICA NATURE PARK (B,L,D)

After breakfast, set sail toward Dugi Otok, pausing for a morning swim stop in one of the tranquil bays. The journey continues through the breathtaking Kornati National Park, an archipelago of stark beauty where dramatic cliffs rise above turquoise waters. Enjoy lunch on board as we glide past the islands, followed by another swim stop to fully immerse yourself in the Adriatic's untouched charm. Later, arrive in Telaš ica Nature Park, a protected haven known for its white cliffs, saltwater lake, and unspoiled landscapes. Take time to explore this serene environment before enjoying dinner on board. Overnight in Telaš ica, surrounded by the peaceful embrace of nature.

TUESDAY: TELAŠ ICA NATURE PARK – MALI LOŠINJ (B,L)

Begin your day with a delightful breakfast, followed by a rejuvenating morning swim. The cruise then continues to the enchanting island of Lošinj, known as the "Island of Vitality" for its lush pine forests, vibrant flora, and healing sea air. After a swim stop and lunch on board, arrive in Mali Lošinj, where a guided walking tour reveals the island's laid-back charm. Visit the Museum of Apoxyomenos, dedicated to the remarkable ancient bronze statue of an athlete found in nearby waters. In the afternoon, enjoy time at your leisure -- perhaps stroll through the Lošinj Aromatic Garden or visit the picturesque town of Veli Lošinj, both within walking distance. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

WEDNESDAY: MALI LOŠINJ - ZADAR (B,L)

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast as the cruise sets sail toward Zadar, passing by the striking, moon-like terrain of Pag Island. Pause along the way for a refreshing swim stop in one of the serene coves, followed by lunch served on board. Upon arrival in Zadar, embark on a guided walking tour through this fascinating coastal city, rich with layers of history and vibrant culture. Explore the remains of the Roman Forum, admire the circular beauty of the St. Donatus Church, and walk along the impressive city walls, including the historic Port and Land Gates. Marvel at modern installations such as the world-famous Sea Organ, which plays music from the sea's movement, and the Greeting to the Sun, a solar-powered light display that dazzles at dusk. In the evening, enjoy dinner in one of Zadar's excellent restaurants before returning to the ship for an overnight stay.

THURSDAY: ZADAR - VODICE - PRIMOŠTEN (B,L, CD)

Cruise into the morning as we sail towards Vodice, a lively seaside town that comes alive during the summer months. Stretch your legs with a stroll along the scenic beaches before continuing the journey to Primošten, one of Dalmatia's most picturesque coastal towns. In the afternoon, explore the stone-paved streets of Primošten and perhaps sample some of the region's acclaimed local wines. As the sun sets, gather for a festive Captain's Dinner on board, complete with live music -- the perfect way to celebrate the journey so far. Overnight in Primošten.

Friday: Day 7. PRIMOŠTEN - TROGIR (Marina Baoti) (B, L)

A relaxing morning cruise brings you from Primošten to Marina Baoti . Along the way, soak up the views of the Dalmatian coast and enjoy a refreshing swim stop before your final onboard lunch. Upon docking at Marina Baoti , guests will board an organized transfer to Split, Croatia's vibrant second-largest city. At 17:00, join a guided walking tour through the lively streets of Split, where layers of history intertwine with a buzzing Mediterranean atmosphere. Explore the awe-inspiring Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that forms the very heart of the old town, and wander past charming cafes,

Overnight stay in Marina Baoti .

SATURDAY: TROGIR (Marina Baoti) (B)

Savour your final breakfast on board as you bid farewell to your crew and fellow travellers. Check-out is by 09:00, followed by transfer to the Split Airport. Depart with lasting memories of Croatia's coastline and the promise of new adventures on the horizon.


